

# Fine collections winter 2024/2025

Fine, Austrian textile editor based in the Tyrolean Alps, focuses on creating fabric collections in the "Modern Country" style.

An interior design concept that can be played in various ways.

In winter 2025, fine is presenting new variations of this familiar theme. The company unfolds a treasure trove filled with fabrics and qualities of unmistakable character.

## **MOUNTAIN DELUXE - Sense of Nature**

2025 is a Mountain Deluxe year. Every two years, Fine presents this signature collection, which gets to the heart of the company's self-image. With great sensitivity, the 2025 collection entitled "Sense of Nature" gets to the bottom of nature in the Alpine region.

This results in fabrics that are inspired by structures and traces in nature and by life in the mountains. Woven in bouclé and chenille, traditionally embroidered or decorated. The colour palette is restraint and characterizes the world of a few gently nuances.

## **TONE IN TONE - the art of nuance**

It's the subtle world of colours that defines this collection. Textures and yarns provide joyful and timeless aesthetics. Plains, faux plains and small patterns are grouped around two expressive qualities: a complex check in muted colors and a stylized leaf design.

### SENSE & LEATHER - an attractive match

With the "LEATHER", fine is fulfilling a long-cherished wish: a genuine leather collection. The collection includes leather in different variations: original and barely processed, lacquered, sanded or roughened. Some à la nature, some in contemporary colours, some velvety and heavenly soft.

SENSE is the antithesis of LEATHER. Bouclé, chenille and melange yarns, knots and loops - the collection comes up with haptically interesting yarns. The result is inspiring fabrics, often with a high/low effect and always with an exciting feel.

SENSE makes a particularly exciting match with LEATHER.

# **SUNDAY - Indoor & Outdoor**

With SUNDAY, fine presents a trend collection that picks up on a current thread: the blurring of the boundaries between indoors and outdoors. The SUNDAY fabrics can do everything they need to do outdoors but feel like the soft and cuddly indoor fabrics they look like.

Again, fine complements the main collections with a whole range of practical basics that adapt smoothly to any interior design concept. These include, above all, the decorative fabrics from the VERTICALS collections and a wool quality called WOOLY.
