

## The basics of LEATHER care

Natural leather is stylish, authentic, and quite demanding. Good care is essential for a long-lasting leather life. Here's everything you need to know about proper leather care:

**Rule # 01:** Provide regular and protective care.

Once the beauty is gone, it may be too late.

Rule # 02: First you clean, then you do the care.

Care products are most effective when the leather is thoroughly clean.

Rule # 03: Dust leather once a week with a dry and soft cloth or with the

soft brush of your hoover. A slightly damp cloth also will work,

but only use distilled water to prevent limescale marks.


Rule # 04: Clean, treat and protect leather furniture twice a year using appropriate


care products. Please note that cleaning and care must be tailored to

the specific characteristics of the leather quality.

## More expert tips

- **Prevent dryness:** Excessively dry environments can result in leather becoming brittle. Care on a weekly basis helps to prevent this. Also, too much moisture can damage the leather.
- Always test cleaning products on a hidden spot before applying them to a visible area.
- Avoid microfibre cloths as they can damage the leather.
- Watch out for **colourful clothing or accessories** that can leave marks. Cover the leather or use strong protection.
- **Protect from sun and heat.** Sunlight and artificial light can bleach and dehydrate the leather. Maintain at least 30 cm distance from heat sources and ensure air circulation under the furniture.
- Leather is prone to scratches from pets, zips and sharp objects. Please avoid contact.
- Treat stains immediately. Dab up liquid with a paper towel and clean with the appropriate KERALUX® product. Avoid applying pressure, as this can push the stain deeper into the leather.
- **Be cautious with household remedies:** They can cause more harm than good, depending on the type of leather.
